Works published between July 1 and December 31, 2022 are to be submitted and postmarked no later than December 31 and must be received by January 7, 2023. Any books postmarked after December 31, 2022 deadline will not be eligible. Please remember to complete all necessary customs/duties paperwork when shipping your entries – to save time and additional costs, at the same time ensuring delays are avoided.

Publishers must undertake to comply with the relevant conditions outlined in Number 5 of the Rules should their submission be shortlisted for The Griffin Poetry Prize.
